Method 1: After entering and squadding all the athletes who will be participating, the head coach may send the athletes the payment URL and athletes may click their individual 'Pay' box for payment and pay individually.

Method 2: Coaches may click on the athletes they will be paying for, and make payment. The coach click on the next athlete and select pay. The program will automatically re populate your information unless you exit the system.
