1-ounce loads are acceptable for use at all USAYESS state, regional, and national International tournaments. Just for information's sake: In Registered International tournaments, athletes are required to use only 24-gram (7/8) ounce ammunition which has a speed up to 1350 fps. This ammunition can be difficult to find, so plan ahead
