For those who do not know Craig, he's 2-time Olympic Gold Medalist & Vincent Hancock's father. Several of Craig's students have podiumed in many ISSF National Championships, ISSF World Cups, and Olympics, including his son Vincent who won back-to-back Olympic Gold Medals, and several ISSF World Cups.

Many coaches and athletes from several other countries come to him or invite him to their countries for coaching. He's arguably one of the world's best. As USAYESS's Olympic Coach, Craig has discounted his fees for USAYESS's Open Mini Camps. It doesn't get any better!

We need at least six students or coaches or a mix thereof for both March 14th and 15th in order to hold the camps.
