

## USA Youth Education in Shooting Sports SCHOLARSHIP

USA Youth Education in Shooting Sports (USAYESS) is proud to offer scholarships to USAYESS high school juniors and seniors members.

USAYESS's priority is to encourage youth to excel academically and develop goals and plans to become productive citizens, and gain respect and knowledge for outdoor activities including firearm safety, and conservation of wildlife and wildlife habitat.

### Procedures:

If the winner of the USAYESS scholarship is enrolled in a college or university, they have one year to use the scholarship. If the scholarship is not used within this time period, the scholarship is forfeited, and funds will be returned to the USAYESS Scholarship fund.

If the recipient of the USAYESS scholarship is on a "full" scholarship (i.e. athletic, academic, military, etc.) the scholarship is forfeited, and funds will be returned to the USAYESS scholarship fund.

All funds will be turned over to the learning institution's financial office and will only available for books, class fees, and or tuition. Funds may not be used for personal items such as computers, printers, phone, etc.

Applicant must have participated in USAYESS for at least one full year and competed in their state championship and Regional or National Championship.

### Application must include:

- One teacher, one employer and one community member's letter of recommendation. Community member cannot be a family member.
- Copy of current high school transcript.
- An essay that is a minimum of 400 words, but no more than 500 words using Calibri 12 font. Essay needs to address why you should be considered for this grant, what your course of study will be, what led you to this course of study, and what your goals and plans are after college. Attention will be given to the essay's structure and grammar.
